Conversation Starters

Talking Points

 - Lydia (Acts 16:11-15)
 - Paul and Silas Imprisoned (Acts 16:16-24)
 - Jailer Converted (Acts 16:25-40)
3. Watch this short clip from Sunday. (can be found on the app or in leader’s email.)
 - What speaks to you from the clip?
4. God has appointments everyday for us, we just need to be walking in the Holy Spirit and listening.
 - Pastor shared this story in the 11am service. There was a side you didn’t get to hear. Someone from our church was at Dave and Busters and they were playing the games there and as they were ready to leave, the man felt God say speak to someone they were near. The man from our church didn’t know personally the person they were supposed to speak to. However, he was obedient and the man he spoke to gave his life to Christ at Dave and Busters. What is crazy about it, is the man isn’t from here and was only here because he was with a traveling nurse. He was just passing through. But God!!! God had an appointment for that man. He came to church Sunday, and the person that led him to Christ will be walking with him on this new journey.
 - Look and listen for those opportunities. They very well could be God appointments!
