Conversation Starters

- Easter is approaching fast! What are some great memories you have from the Easter season growing up?

Talking Points

1. Ask your Life Group what spoke to them, a phrase or moment from the sermon they related to the most, or questions they have.
2. Pastor shared a quote from Theodore Roosevelt, *"People don't care how much you know until they know how much you care."*
 - What are your thoughts about this quote?
 - How do you see this quote when applied to sharing the Gospel?
3. Have you ever been discouraged when sharing the gospel? (For example, you didn't see the results you were hoping for?) Share a story you may have.
4. Read 1 Corinthians 3:6-9.
 - What speaks or encourages you in this passage?
5. Watch this short clip from Sunday. (can be found on the app or in leader's email.)
 - Which sponge are you currently?
6. These are quick and easy verses to remember to lead someone to Christ. They are known as the "Roman Road."
Read through them as a group.
 - Romans 3:23 / 6:23 / 10:9-10
